
ASMQ Dosing:

- Artesunate + Mefloquine dosages are available in 25/50 mg and 100/200 mg sized tablets
- Dosage and number of pills used are dependent on weight, if the weight is not known, use age ranges

Do not use ASMQ for:

- Patients who have received Mefloquine in the last 4 weeks
- Patients with a history of seizures or epilepsy
- 3 Pregnant women in their first trimester

If patient vomits after treatment of ASMQ



..within **30 minutes** of taking ACT, retreat with a **full dose**




..between **30 and 60 minutes** of taking ACT,
retreat with a **half dose**



..after 60 minutes, do not retreat

Primaquine



Administer single low dose Primaquine for P.f. and mix only on the first day of ASMQ treatment

Do not treat pregnant and breastfeeding women

Tell patient to always take with food!

If patient vomits, no Primaquine shall be given to patient after the vomit.
